

# Preventive measures to avoid COVID-19 JOBSITE

In order to limit the impact and spread of the virus as much as possible, we expect all of the employees on site to adhere strictly to the following measures:

#### 1. FIRST AND FOREMOST:

Employees with symptoms of illness stay at home.

### 2. FOLLOW PREVENTIVE HYGIENE AT ALL TIMES:



Wash your hands regularly and thoroughly with soap and water. At least 20 sec.



Avoid giving hands when greeting someone.



Cough or sneeze in a paper handkerchief or in the inside of your elbow.



Avoid contact with people who are visibly ill and keep sufficient distance.



Avoid touching your face with your hands:

#### 3. SOCIAL DISTANCING DURING TRANSPORT TO AND FROM CONSTRUCTION SITES:

- Where possible, employees drive directly to the construction site and public transport must be avoided.
- The foreman does use the company car for transfers to and from the construction site.

# 4. SOCIAL DISTANCING ON SITE:

- Avoid all unnecessary social contacts.
- Meetings, toolboxes and breaks must be held preferably in the open air rather than in the shed. Maintain at least 2 meters distance between each other and no physical items are passed on.
- Large concentrations of persons in the shed are not allowed. A maximum of 4 people may be present in a shed at the same time and a distance of 2 meters must be kept at all times.
- Ventilate sufficiently by opening the windows.
- Sanitary facilities and shed are cleaned very frequently.

## 5. THE USE OF EQUIPMENT ON SITE

- Everyone works as much as possible with their own equipment.
- Everyone wears work gloves when using shared equipment. Extra gloves are available in the warehouse.
- Shared equipment must be regularly cleaned and disinfected.
